



Learning Map for Year 2: Autumn 2025

Number and Place Value:

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a 2-digit number.
- Compare and order numbers 0 to 100 using $>$ $<$ $=$ signs.
- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and words.

Addition and Subtraction:

- Solve addition and subtraction problems using concrete objects and pictorial representations.
- Recall addition and subtraction facts up to 20 and relate these to related facts up to 100.
- Add and subtract numbers using a variety of strategies.
- Show understanding that addition is commutative and that addition and subtraction have an inverse relationship.

The children will also develop a range of skills including:

- Revising Y1 learning such as: capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
- Using a range of correct punctuation to demarcate different sentences.
- Using conjunctions 'and', 'or' and 'but' to join sentences.
- Using nouns, verbs, adjectives and noun phrases confidently.
- Spelling Y1/2 common exception words correctly.
- Using the present and past tense consistently.
- Writing in a cursive style, forming letters correctly.
- Proofreading and correcting writing.

Please read with your child at least 5 times a week focussing on: decoding, comprehension and prosody.
