History: World War II
Looking at WWII and the events surrounding it- knowing the timeline of these key events. Explore life as an evacuee and investigate what life was like in WWII- including Dig for Victory, Make Do and Mend. Reflect on discrimination and learn about the persecution of Jewish people.

Light
Recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines and use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye. Explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes and use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them. Investigate and create periscopes linked to submarines during WW2.

Geography: UK vs. Germany
Look at the UK, comparing it to another area of the world- Germany. We will work to understand geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of in both regions. Describe and understand key aspects of, Physical geography (e.g. climate zones, and vegetation belts) and Human geography (including types of settlement and land use, economic activity, including trade links and the distribution of natural resources including energy, food, minerals and water). Make comparisons between WW!! UK and Germany and Modern Day.

Electricity
Describe and associate the brightness of a lamp or volume of a buzzer with the number and voltage of cells used in the circuit. Compare and give reasons for variations in how components function, including the brightness of bulbs, the loudness of buzzers and the on/off position of switches. Use recognised symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram.
