- ✓ Companies can match the fundraising total for an event.

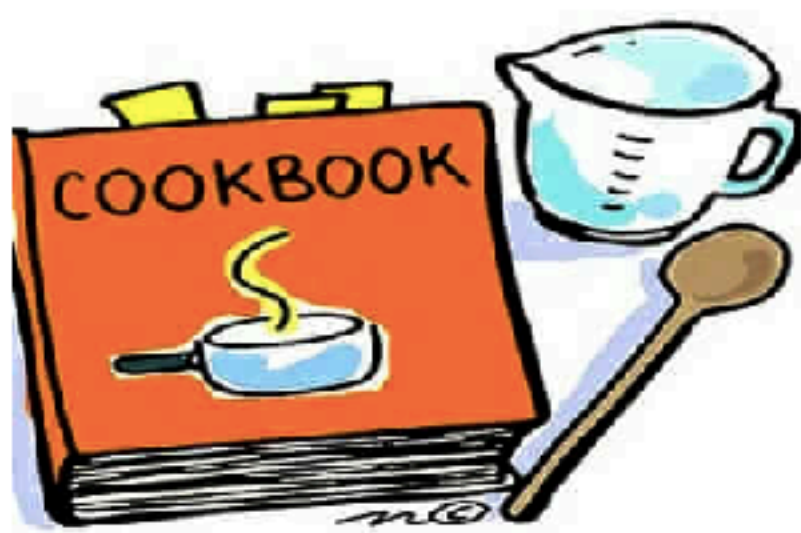
### *What do I need to do?*
